Eleven essays on Southeast Asian literature, culture, art and religion by Sinhalese (Sri Lankan) author Martin Wickramasinghe (1890-1976). The two main essays concern the Jakatas (Buddhist writings on the various incarnations of the Buddha), while the shorter, latter essays address various aspects of Indian and Sri Lankan art and literature. All make Southeast Asian culture highly comprehensible to the Western reader. The book is in very good condition.
